

Pontesbury Neighbourhood Plan - Objectives

From our recent public consultation throughout the parish, five themes emerged as important for you. **Have we got it right?**

Rural Landscape and Open Spaces

1. To preserve the rural character and open spaces
2. To support development which enhances the AONB and Plealey conservation area
3. To protect the natural habitats, wildlife and biodiversity

Protecting/developing community amenities

1. To enhance facilities and services for a vibrant community
2. To improve links between services and shops

Provision of adequate housing

1. To allow future infill development in Pontesbury which respects its variety of building styles and materials
2. Limited infill in each settlement which respects rural outlook and maintains gaps between settlements and avoids elements of suburbanisation
3. To assist the provision of an appropriate number of smaller sized houses and affordable homes

Movement and transport

1. To encourage the provision of safe and convenient public transport to reduce pollution and car use
2. To support safe, accessible network of roads, cycleways and footpaths to promote healthier lifestyles
3. To improve car parking in Pontesbury

Employment and business opportunities

1. To encourage suitable employment opportunities including tourism
2. To support farming diversification which brings landscape benefits.
